INVITATION: APPLICATIONS FOR SANCOLD SCHOLARSHIP FOR MASTER'S STUDIES IN DAM ENGINEERING: 2008-2009

1. INTRODUCTION

In order to promote the resource base in **Dam Engineering**, SANCOLD will award a single scholarship at a time. It will be awarded to an outstanding applicant towards obtaining a **Master's Degree in South Africa.**

1.1 Mobility of scholarship-holder

SANCOLD scholarships will assist Master's students to undertake studies and research in the general field of *Dam Engineering* and to take advantage of the best possible training opportunities in South Africa. These scholarships will allow the holders mobility, as well as the freedom to select supervisors in their chosen fields. The purpose of these scholarships is to support persons who are committed to contributing significantly to research, teaching and professional practice in the field of Dam Engineering in their future careers. Students will access these scholarships in their own right and will not need to be linked to a specific higher education institution when applying, but letters of reference will be required to support the application.

Scholarship-holders will be identified well in advance of commencement of their envisaged studies to give them the opportunity to consult with and identify their supervisors prior to the start of the academic year.

2. ELIGIBILITY

These scholarships are available to suitably qualified South African citizens for full-time Master's studies at a South African university.

2.1 Eligibility to apply for SANCOLD scholarship

Applications for a scholarship for Master's studies may be submitted by the following persons:

 students or graduates who have either successfully completed or are enrolled for the Fourth Year of their Undergraduate studies in the case of degree courses which directly allow access to a Master's degree, e.g. Engineering, etc.;

- students who have either successfully completed or are enrolled for their BSc Honours or Final Year BTech degree but who have not yet enrolled for Master's studies;
- students or graduates who have, in their most recent examination, obtained an aggregate of at least 60% for the subject(s) with which they wish to continue at Master's level;

2.2 Please note the following:

Students who wish to receive scholarships for Master's studies have to apply prior to commencement of their Master's studies

3. FIELDS OF STUDY SUPPORTED

The SANCOLD scholarship is awarded for postgraduate studies leading to a research-based Master's degree in any field that would be appropriate to Dam Engineering, e,g, Structural, Hydraulic, Geotechnical, Project Economics, Flood Hydrology; Environmental, Dam Safety; etc.

4. VALUE OF SCHOLARSHIP

4.1 What does the scholarship cover?

Awards are made to contribute towards the cost of tuition, accommodation, books and academic supplies.

4.2 Size of Scholarship for 2008-2009

The following value per annum applies for this period: R 40 000

SANCOLD encourages institutions to supplement the scholarship-holders' income by assigning appropriate research and teaching tasks to them that will contribute to the progress of obtaining their respective degrees. Awardees will be allowed to undertake a maximum of nine hours of teaching, tutorials, assistance or demonstration duties per week on average during the year of study. Scholarship-holders may not be employed on a part-time basis if their working hours exceed nine hours, during office hours, per week on average during the year of study. Scholarship-holders may not hold full-time salaried employment during the tenure of the scholarship.

SANCOLD scholarships may be held concurrently with other bursaries or scholarships.

5. PERIODS OF SUPPORT

Support in terms of Master's degree scholarships will be considered for the following maximum period: **2 years**.

6. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applicants are invited to apply for the SANCOLD Scholarship, by completing the attached application form. Applicants should retain copies of materials submitted for their records.

Applicants are requested to read the accompanying instruction sheet before completing the Application Form and to follow the instructions carefully. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

The Closing Date for receipt of applications by SANCOLD is 14 February 2008.

As indicated in the instruction sheet, applicants are required to approach two reviewers for reports on their academic performance. Engineers or faculty members who have current knowledge of the applicant's academic and/or professional experience and ability should be selected as reviewers, since they will be able to give meaningful answers to the questions asked. At least one of the two should be a person with whom the applicant has worked in his/her present (or most recent) academic department, including the latest supervisor, if applicable. Applicants are urged to provide the reviewers of their choice with the Assessment Form immediately and to request the reviewers to forward these forms directly, to reach SANCOLD as soon as possible but not later than 14 February 2008. The onus will be on the applicants to ensure that these reports reach the SANCOLD office in time.

7. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Applicants will be requested to indicate the institution where they will in all likelihood register for their intended studies. Once the award is made known, the successful candidate will be required to sign an agreement with SANCOLD and to provide proof of registration for the degree/diploma concerned before the scholarship will be paid to the institution on behalf of the scholarshipholder.

After an award is made, support for the second year is subject to the supervisor's confirmation that the scholarship-holder is making good progress in the approved field of study.

Students who do not obtain the degree for which the scholarship was awarded, relinquish their studies or leave the university/Technical University during the period for which the scholarship was awarded, will have to refund all payment of the scholarship already received, plus interest.

Students are required to send SANCOLD brief details of the posts they take up after completing their degree.

8. SELECTION CRITERIA AND EVALUATION

The award of these scholarships to students will be based on exceptional potential and academic performance. Selection criteria will include academic merit, promise of research ability, leadership qualities, and need. The likelihood that the candidate will successfully complete a Master's degree will also be a significant criterion.

The assessment of candidates will be based on all available evidence of ability and potential, including academic records and recommendations regarding each applicant's qualifications and may involve interviewing potential candidates. Selection of the awardee will be done on merit as determined by the SANCOLD selection committee whose decision shall be final.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE "APPLICATION FORM"

GENERAL

Before completing the "Application Form", please read the "Invitation for Applications" (dated January 2008) enclosed for background information concerning SANCOLD scholarships which will be awarded to outstanding applicants towards doing research for a Master's degree in South Africa in the general field of Dam Engineering.

SANCOLD Scholarships may be held concurrently with other scholarships, fellowships or bursaries. Candidates who are salaried employees during the tenure of the Scholarship applied for, are not eligible for SANCOLD support.

Incomplete, late applications or applications other than on the attached form will not be considered. On completion of the form, please consult the checklist at the end of these instructions to ensure that all the required information has been submitted.

COMPLETION OF APPLICATION FORM

Some of the SANCOLD reviewers will only be able to evaluate your application if it is submitted in English. For this reason it would be in your best interest to submit your application in English. Applications must be completed in typescript (MS Word). All the Sections of the application form have to be completed fully.

Applicants are requested to -

- forward the completed application form to your Head of Department or your current employer for completion of Section J and their signature;
- forward the completed Application Form to SANCOLD by secure post before the Closing Date;
- check with the reviewers they selected that the Assessment Forms have been sent to SANCOLD before the Closing Date.

NB: The onus will be on the applicants to ensure that the application forms reach SANCOLD on time.

Section A

Self-Explanatory

Section B

Complete details are required. The identity number supplied must be verified by attaching a copy of the relevant page of the identity document (ID). If the ID document is not yet available, proof of citizenship should be attached.

Section C

To be completed as thoughtfully and concisely as possible. Should applicants have held bursaries for their previous studies which bind them to enter into the service of the contract holder on completion of the studies, SANCOLD will require a statement from the contract holder in which it is stated that -

- deferment of assumption of duty has been granted so that the candidate can pursue further research/studies;
- the contract holder has no objection to the applicant receiving the requested SANCOLD scholarship.

Section D

A full certified academic record must be attached up to and including the mid-year marks of the current year of studies, if available. In cases where applicants hold degrees from institutions abroad, their study records must be formally equated to South African norms by the applicant. The equated record should indicate what the South African equivalent of the qualification is, as well as the level at which it was obtained (i.e. percentages obtained).

Section E

Please list all awards and the amounts received, if applicable.

Sections F and G

The instructions on the application form are self-explanatory.

Section H

Please ensure that all the particulars requested are supplied as accurately as possible.

Section I

Sign the application form and have your signature witnessed.

Section J

For completion by the Head of Department or the Applicant's current employer.

scholarship applicant)

Applications and assessment forms which are received by SANCOLD after the closing dates specified above will not be considered.

It is advisable to request the completion of the Assessment forms by reviewers as soon as possible to ensure their submission to SANCOLD by the closing date. Late submissions will not be accepted.
